25 5. The parties have conferred and agree to the existing hearing date of April 24, 2009

27 6. The parties request that the Court reserve two hours for the trial.

28 7. The purpose of this stipulation is to establish a schedule for certifying and lodging

1 the record, filing an answer, memoranda, and having the case heard. Nothing in this stipulation
2 shall be construed as an admission or waiver with respect to any prayers for relief or affirmative
3 defenses pled by the parties or by an appearance or consent to jurisdiction by any party.
