

What's going on here?

Teichert is moving an asphalt plant into the Chevreux quarry at the end of Combie Rd. in Meadow Vista. They propose to use it to furnish material (290,000 tons) to repave I-80.

The project is supposed to run for 6-7 months in 2005 and 2006. Each night, trucks will travel on Combie & Placer Hills Rd. around 250-280 times (every 3 min.) from 7 pm to 5 am.

On many days liquid asphalt, and/or propane fuel will be delivered to the plant.

Placer County Planning, Placer County Air Pollution Control District, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, Nevada Irrigation District and other agencies are considering whether a permit first issued in 1972 will apply to this project.

Area residents have formed a non-profit corporation, **Meadow Vista Protection (MVP)**, to learn more and voice their concerns.

The group hopes to make sure that the asphalt plant proposal will receive **appropriate environmental impact review.**

Membership in MVP is open to all.
