

## **Meadow Vista Protection Update September 17, 2007**

Greetings. You are receiving this email because you have previously expressed interest in Meadow Vista Protection (MVP).

MVP held a critical update meeting on September 12th at the Beda Place in Meadow Vista with a strong turnout of members in attendance that provided important feedback and direction to the board. However, many of you were unable to be at that meeting due to conflicts and we wanted to update you on what occurred that night.

Please see the attached slide set presented that evening. MVP attendees urged us to continue on with fighting the asphalt plant and suggested that we obtain pledges from our membership and the email list before proceeding with new counsel. We gave everyone in the room a slip of paper to make their pledge at the meeting. We asked for an email address, your ten day gift and your six month gift (tax deductible).

**That night we received immediate pledges for \$19,625 (due by the 22nd) and \$24,725 of additional pledges due over the next six months.** We are bringing the same request to all of you today. **We need to raise an additional \$15,375 worth of pledges this week to make the \$35,000 retainer due next week and at least another \$25,000 over the next six months to continue.** Please help us reach these two important goals so that we can continue our struggle against Meadow Vista becoming an asphalt town. If we do nothing, it won't be long before the asphalt trucks start rolling past our homes at night for work on highway 80 or highway 49.

**Please commit your pledge today by replying to this email with the amount you can send to our P.O. box within the next ten days** and the amount you can give over the next six months to continue the fight ( P.O. Box 1165, Meadow Vista, CA 95722). **Please urge your neighbors to get involved and help with this important struggle.**

That night we also distributed lawn signs and bumper stickers and we still have a few signs left. We are getting more printed for distribution at our next meeting. **Please do not place these signs or bumper stickers on public property** such as county road signs or buildings. This will end up hurting our cause and add some potential legal grief to MVP. Some of these signs have MVP's URL printed on them.
